

## MWAA 2011 Great Passport GiveAway Promotion Rules and Concert Prize

MWAA will draw names randomly from anyone pre-registered for the MWAA 2011 Conference and who has completed the Passport program. One of the prizes for the MWAA Great Passport GiveAway is concert tickets and a hotel stay. Two attendees will be selected to receive this prize. The two selected attendees will each receive two tickets to the Paul McCartney Wrigley Field Concert, 7:00pm on Sunday, July 31, 2011. The tickets are valued at \$500.00 each and are prime field seats. (See MWAA item 3 below) The MWAA will also cover the cost of the selected attendees stay for the weekend at the Oak Brook Hills Marriott Resort Hotel in Oak Brook, IL. The awarding of the concert/hotel stay prizes is subject to these conditions:

### Selected attendee must

1. Be pre-registered for the MWAA 2011 Conference through the MWAA web site before 5pm Central, Friday, July 15<sup>th</sup>.
2. Attend the MWAA 2011 conference and complete the Passport program, subject to the Passport rules. Concert tickets will not be given to selected attendees who register but do not attend complete the Passport program requirements. Tickets for the concert (or at the sole discretion of the MWAA, its cash equivalent) will be given to the selected attendees on Thursday evening, July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at the MWAA 2011 Conference Passport GiveAway after the closing reception. You must be present to win.
3. Sign a waiver that releases the MWAA from all liability relative to the concert and the weekend hotel stay.
4. Accept the concert/hotel stay prize as offered by the MWAA. If the MWAA offers the tickets, they must be accepted as is. If the MWAA offers the cash equivalent of the tickets, the selected attendee must accept the cash. The selected attendee must take the weekend hotel stay as offered for July 29-31, 2011 or forfeit the hotel stay.
5. Accept sole responsibility for all Federal, state and local taxes incurred by this GiveAway. The selected attendee must also fill out a W-9 form and give it to the MWAA.

### The MWAA

1. May, at its sole discretion, provide a cash substitute for the concert tickets. (See MWAA item 3 below.)
2. Will cover the cost of the hotel stay at the Oak Brook Marriott Resort for Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights, July 29-31, 2011, double occupancy regular room and tax only. The selected attendee may not transfer the weekend hotel stay to any third party. The weekend hotel stay includes room and tax only. Selected attendee is responsible for all other hotel fees incurred. There is no cash equivalent for the hotel stay.
3. Has sourced the tickets from a third-party ticket broker. The MWAA makes no guarantees about the efficacy of the concert tickets since they have been sourced from a third-party ticket broker. In the event that the tickets would not be honored by the concert venue, the MWAA will provide a cash equivalent of the tickets as its only remedy.
4. Will provide tax information to the IRS relative to the prizes awarded.
